Wasatch Lingo

- Wasatch STARS – smart, thoughtful, aware, respectful students.
- Town Meeting – every class has the opportunity to perform for the whole school. The class works with our drama and music teachers to choreograph and create a performance that builds on the learning they are doing in their classroom.

School Community Council

- We are a group of parents and faculty who meet monthly to help determine what happens to federal pass through money. This year Wasatch had about \$50,000 we primarily spent on interventionists -- educators to help struggling students – and a computer specialist.
