a. Faculty report/ SIC - Dawn Ann Bullough

- b. PTA did not vote to fund an additional iPad, approximately \$600 for Mr. Colman until further research is completed related to existing faculty iPads and whether all teachers are utilizing them; Deb Candler will investigate.
- iii. Rachel will publish an article that describes how PTA has spent donations thus far for the December school newsletter

e. Volunteer Coordinator's Report - Augusta Comey

- i. We use <u>Signup Genius</u> to organize volunteers; signup.com (formerly volunteerspot.com) has limitations; Rachel Preslar will discontinue our \$99/annual fee for signup.com
- ii. Deb Candler reported that Salt Lake City School District installed two kiosk computers in the Main Office for volunteers to use to check in, print badges, and check out; hours reporting capabilities possible; Augusta will alert parents about the new process
- iii. Picture retake day is 11/10; Stephanie Quintero and Rosann Greenway volunteered to assist

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1. S.A.F.E. Neighborhoods- Jenn Hein

- a. Jenn Hein, Wasatch parent, is looking for momentum to create the connection between the <u>Salt Lake City S.A.F.E. Neighborhoods</u> program and the Salt Lake City School District so the community can actually use Wasatch Elementary in case of a disaster, as mandated:
