#### a. SIC (School Improvement Committee) - Beth Tanner

- i. Week in March for Wasatch community service related to Meadowlark Elementary
- ii. Science Fair preparation for 5th & 6th grades, 12/19/19
- iii. State of Utah has adopted new science standards; Wasatch is an early adopter;  $6^{th}$  grade is already participating;
- iv. Parents are not to contact kids on their phones or phone watches during the school day
- v. Students were surveyed on their emotional and social needs (SEL : Social & Emotional Learning); part of a national survey but neither data nor results available yet

## b. Principal's report - Deborah Candler

i. Reviewed Wasatch air quality policy: kids stay inside for recess when there is orange air, even though SLC School District says it's OK for kids to be outside; Wasatch needs to support both kids and teachers to create inside-recess plan for kids who need to stay active, or quiet to reset; parents support kids being safe inside and also support engaging, productive indoor activities

ii. Love & Logic begins anew Jan 8, 2020

iii. To address the challenge of waste reduction in the cafeteria, Deborah Candler has contracted Wasatch Resource Recovery to haul away recycled items; cost is \$88/month and is funded in part by the Wasatch generous families Oscarson and Terry and in part by money Deborah Candler has received from GreenFiber, a recycling vendor; students need to be educated about how to manage cafeteria waste; parents are welcome between 11a – 1220p for lunch duty to help kids figure it out;

i. Brandon Bennett discussed elections for SCC next year; elections might encourage attendance for representatives; also discussed returning to faculty grade-level representatives


